



Woodcote Primary School

Year 5/6 Curriculum Fact Sheet

Spring 2019

This sheet gives you some information about some of the work your children will be involved in during this term. It would be very difficult to detail everything so we have just included those topics which we feel are the most relevant and those in which you could support your child's learning.

 <p style="text-align: center;">English</p>	<p>This term we will be using the text '1001 Arabian Nights' as a stimulus for our own story writing. We will also be studying poems about rivers, to learn about different poetic techniques before having a go at composing our own.</p> <p>We will continue developing our grammar and punctuation skills and spellings will be set weekly. Please support your child to learn these spellings, which are glued inside their planners each week.</p> <p>Whole class guided reading sessions take place throughout the week and for year six these will be more focused towards succeeding in SATs style comprehension exercises. In year 5, the children will be working on the book 'Wonder'. The children will need to also focus on using cursive handwriting and present their work to a high standard.</p>
 <p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p>	<p>In year 6, we will be learning how to calculate averages and how to interpret and construct pie charts. We will also be learning how to solve simple algebraic formulae and will be improving our skills in drawing shapes and angles. In addition to this, we will be converting between units of measure, including imperial.</p> <p>In year 5, we will be looking at and investigating the relationship between fractions, percentages and decimals. We will be learning how to find the area and perimeter of shapes, read and interpret information in tables and graphs, as well as revisiting other topics we have already covered. Both years regularly practise number calculation skills.</p>
 <p style="text-align: center;">Science</p>	<p>This term, both year 5 and year 6 will be learning about light. They will be finding out how we see, how light travels and how shadows are formed.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Topic (this includes all foundation subjects)</p> 	<p>Our topics this term include Ancient Islamic Civilisation and Rivers. Both of these topics will involve developing skills in history and geography as well as providing opportunities for creative work. We also will be continuing our progress in computing using Purple Mash.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">i-learn</p> 	<p>Our 3M challenges begin soon. To prepare, our i-learns this term will be packed with ideas to help the children. Please encourage your children to do this homework as we feel this is excellent preparation for them as they prepare to move on to secondary school / Year 6.</p>
