



### What is the Sports Premium?

This year, the Government has given every primary school in the U.K a Sports Premium Fund, which is to be used to improve the delivery and teaching of P.E.

### How are we spending the money to improve P.E. and Sport in our school?

We are spending the majority of the fund, in co-operation with nearly all of the primary schools in North West Leicestershire, on the services provided to us by the North West Leicestershire School Sports Partnership (NWLSSP). These services include amongst others:

- Providing before, during and after school clubs for our children to attend.
- A qualified sports coach providing continued professional development for all our staff to enhance their P.E. teaching.
- All sports competitions and festivals which are available for us to enter throughout the year.
- Further training and education opportunities for our staff to continue to improve their P.E. teaching.

In addition to this, we will also spend the money on transport costs, to allow our children to attend sports competitions, buying resources and equipment, providing opportunities for our staff to train and improve P.E. and sports provision in our school and also provide extra swimming lessons for children who may not achieve national curriculum targets by the end of primary school.

### Current P.E. Curriculum

We provide a wide and varied P.E. curriculum here, through at least two hours of a range of games, gymnastics, dance and swimming every week. These activities are the vehicles through which we aim to develop key physical skills and these skills are practised and progressed through your child's time here.

## Sports Provision

We aim to ensure that all children in our school participate in competitions within the school (Level 1 competitions) over the year, and that all Key Stage Two children have the opportunities to participate in intra-school competitions (Level 2 competitions).
